Ms. Frankic reported on the progress with the Louisiana Office of Community Development on the CDBG-DR appropriation requiring an Action Plan Amendment to be approved by HUD. She shall ask Senator Harris to provide guidance on the breakdown between City Park and FQMD. She shall also follow up with City Park as to their progress in proceeding with the HUD approval.
