



V. Discussion of the French Quarter Economic Development District sales tax renewal referendum There will be a special meeting of the Board of Commissioners on Wednesday to discuss the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement that will govern the FQ EDD. The two plans are similar but have some differences.

A five percent administrative fee, capped at \$120,000, would be paid to FQMD to cover the expense of a licensing agreement for the French Quarter Task Force, or equivalent, user application and to hold public meetings to make recommendations and report any complaints about the "Unified Patrol French Quarter Corps", however, no recourse is for such complaints is prescribed 	
The FQ EDD Cooperative Endeavor Agreement cannot be terminated without cause	The Mayor can terminate the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement at any time	
The FQ EDD Trust Fund shall not be used to replace existing City services	The Mayor can use the Trust Fund to supplant current City obligations, such as the \$225,000 contract for private security in Armstrong Park.	
The FQ EDD Trust Fund can only be used for services within the boundaries of the FQ EDD/FQMD	French Market Corporation managed property includes locations outside of the District and maps of FMC property are included in the Mayor's plan.	
The FQ EDD Trust Fund shall use post-certified officers for replicating the existing FQMD Supplemental Police Patrol Program including patrol routes, strategies, FQTF, or equivalent, user application, reporting procedures, and technology. It will be configured to align with the structure of other neighborhood security districts with dedicated tax funding utilizing a NOPD Full Time Coordinating Officer under the supervision of the NOPD 8th District Captain.	The New Orleans Office of Homeland Security & Emergency Preparedness creates a new blue light patrol with NOHSEP administration coordinating with the NOPD utilizing both NOPD overtime officers and non-post-certified armed grounds patrol security guards.	
The FQ EDD Trust shall be used to enforce all criminal laws regarding public safety	NOHSEP will monitor the FQ EDD for City Code compliance and/or Quality of Life infractions and issue Municipal Citations for violators.
