
FQ Task Force Summary



- 1. Restore the New Orleans Police Department 8TH District officer count to the pre-Hurricane Katrina count of 165 fulltime officers
- 2. Increase FQTF revenue via consolidating security services
- 3. Launch legal and/or material initiatives to reduce illegal guns within the district
- 4. Ensure that the crash rated impact bollards on Bourbon Street and traffic barricades on Royal Street are deployed on a daily schedule and on emergency basis
- 5. Release Security Assessment for public consumption
- 6. Develop list of actionable items from Security Assessment and execute items on the list

Commissioner Jane Cooper will be the committee chair for 2021 with Commissioner Matthew Emory as the committee vice-chair.
