  - Officers Working 9 days per 2-week Period (was 10)
  - Staffing for FQTF Shifts Will Be Impacted but Fills Ins Should be Available
- Staffing During the Recent Hurricanes was Challenging
- Overall Staffing for Oct was 96%
- Vehicle Repairs – 2 repairs in October (1 Smart Car & 1 Polaris)
- LSP Troop N Staffing Reductions Continue:
  - Working One 12-hour Shift Per Day at the Moment
- No Issues without G4S Manning the FQTF Desk

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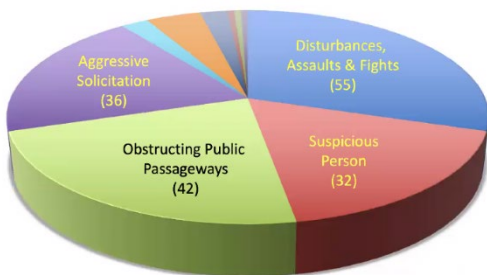

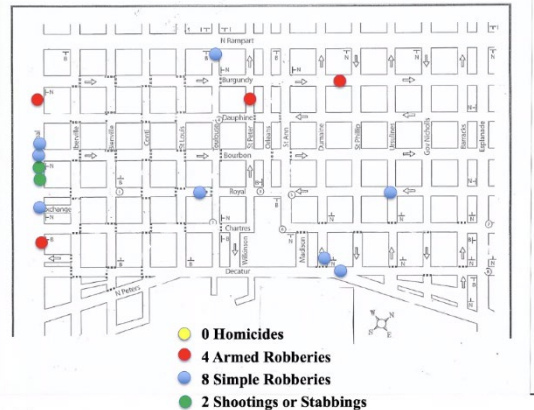

1. Restore the New Orleans Police Department 8<sup>TH</sup> District officer count to the pre-Hurricane Katrina count of 165 fulltime officers
2. Increase FQTF revenue via consolidating security services
3. Launch legal and/or material initiatives to reduce illegal guns within the district
4. Ensure that the crash rated impact bollards on Bourbon Street and traffic barricades on Royal Street are deployed on a daily schedule and on emergency basis
5. Release Security Assessment for public consumption
6. Develop list of actionable items from Security Assessment and execute items on the list

Commissioner Jane Cooper will be the committee chair for 2021 with Commissioner Matthew Emory as the committee vice-chair.
