#### 2. Public Comment:

No public comment was received.

3. Approval of previous meeting notes (action item)

Ms. Cooper made the motion to approve the previous meeting notes. Mr. Caputo seconded motion and it was approved.

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#### 4. Committee Chair's Comments

Mr. Emory thanked the Committee for their work and noted the importance of continuing to work together in a productive manner to address the important business ahead of the Committee.

5. Report on French Quarter Crime Stats by NOPD 8th District

Sgt. Roach reported on the 8<sup>th</sup> District crime stats are overall down 61% for this time last year. Person crimes are down 36%, aggravated battery is down 62%, simple robbery is down 57%, purse snatching down 20%, aggravated battery by shootings up by 150% but all five have been cleared by the officers and detectives, Property Crimes year to date are down 53%, business burglaries and residence burglaries are up but have a 75% clearance rate, auto burglaries are up 71% which is also across the city with, with clearance rate at 9%.

#### 6. Report on the French Quarter Task Force program by NOPD Sgt Jamie Roach

Last week 76 calls for service: 58 app calls, 18 dispatch calls, and 815 self-initiated calls for service for a total of 892 calls. This includes 9 suspicious person calls, 23 obstruction of public passageways calls, 12 disturbances, 4 drug dealing, 6 aggressive solicitation, 2 thefts, and 3 oversized vehicles. Dispatch calls were 9 services, 1 drug dealing and 1 theft. Patrol officers conducted 11 business checks, 181 citizen contacts, 47 subjects moved, 1 traffic citation, 2 filed identification cards, and 1 summons. 99.1% of shifts were filled.

Sgt. Roach reported that patrol officers are going well with the patrols and all of the same officers that were working the detail before are back working the patrols. They are responding well to her and are responding quickly to calls. Mr. Simms reported that the program is running better now then when he was running it with a Sergeant that is very engaged with the patrol officers.

Ms. Cooper asked about the impact of the increase in numbers of tourists out in the French Quarter if Sgt. Roach is adjusting the patrols? Sgt. Roach said that she can flex the officers to address changes in crime trends in particular areas.

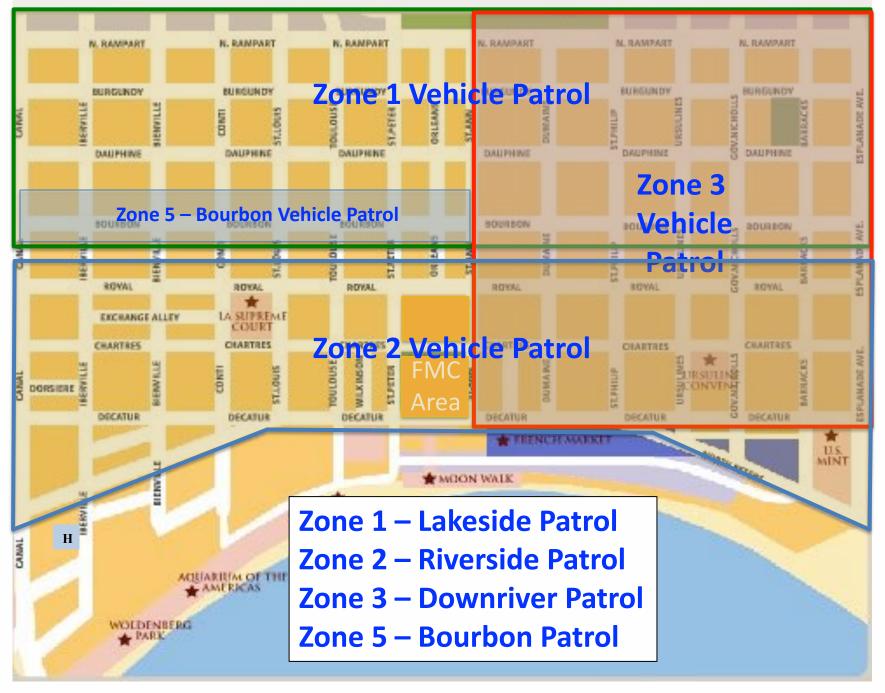

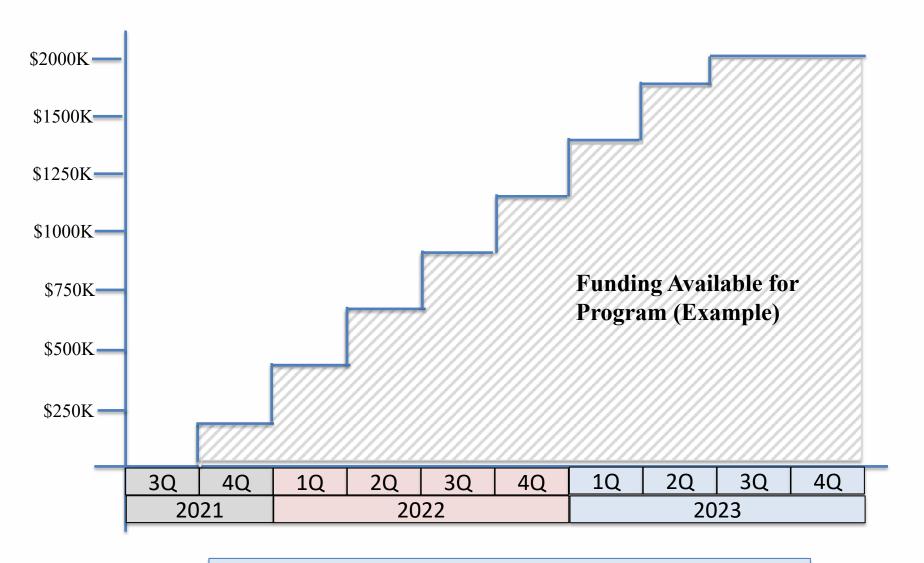

# FQ EDD - Budget Development Recommendations

Provide a checks and balance inclusive public forum for all stakeholders to work collaboratively to ensure the EDD Blue Light Patrol Program and the EDD Trust Fund are managed with transparency and accountability:

- Expand SEC working team and redefine as "FQMD/CNO EDD Trust Fund Advisory Group" with monthly public meetings
- Current SEC working team Gail Cavett, Robert Watters, Steve Caputo, Bob Simms, Glade Bilby and NOPD Capt. Caprera
- Add EDD Governing Authority and City representatives to participate in the meetings
- Report to SEC and FQMD Board at monthly board meeting.

## FQ EDD Advisory Group - Process

- Monthly Review and Reconcile EDD Trust Fund Income and Expenses
- Develop operational plans and budget recommendations based on revenue stream projections and expenditures.
- Review NOPD staffing costs, vehicle purchases, maintenance, fuel, tires, parts, and other supplies and operating expenses
- Develop NOPD Blue Light Patrol Operations Plans
  - Develop NOPD patrol shifts, zone coverage, and officer staffing
- Review and develop program performance indicators and stats
- Develop recommendations for monthly advance EDD Trust Fund disbursements to the City for officer costs and vehicle expenses mentioned above. Funds deposited into City Special Account and reconciled at monthly meetings (City provides Balance Sheet for special account).
- Review and reconcile monthly Trust Funds received and disbursed by FQMD.
   (FQMD provides Balance Sheet for special account)
- If FQMD and the City disagree on decisions for the above-mentioned items, both parties can present their information to the EDD Governing Authority at the Agreement Monitor meetings.
