What To Do

- Did you know that removing graffiti quickly often deters taggers from coming back?
- Rinse with garden hose and mild soap
- Report it to VCC and VCGAP
- Select the most appropriate product for your needs. If masonry, a poultice type of cleaner is generally preferred, similar to Peel Away products
- Get your permit. The VCC will recommend approved products. Permits are reusable as written (you don't have to keep reapplying for the same problem).
- Follow product directions or hire a skilled contractor

Best practices for preservation from NCPTT Vieux Carre Commission (Permit Required)

- First and foremost: Do No Harm
- · Retain the historic fabric and original material
- Minimally impact original materials
- Help maintain and protect the resource

Laws

It is illegal to deface with graffiti any structure located within a National Register Historic District - RS 14:56.5

Wood

• Graffiti on a wood surface should be primed and painted as noted in Repainting, page 09-2

Masonry

- Graffiti should be removed quickly to prevent it from permanently adhering to masonry (Prompt removal is a City requirement)
- Removal technique depends on type of masonry materials
