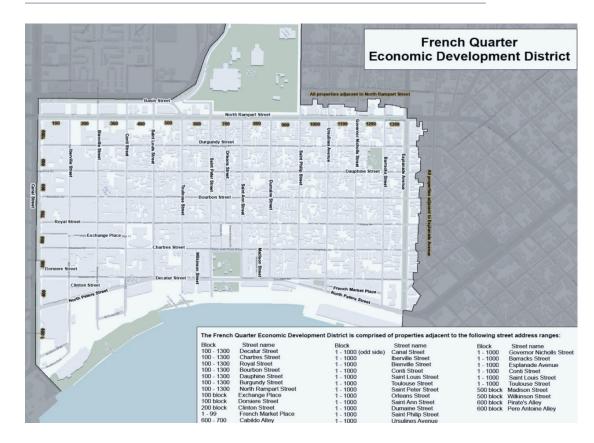
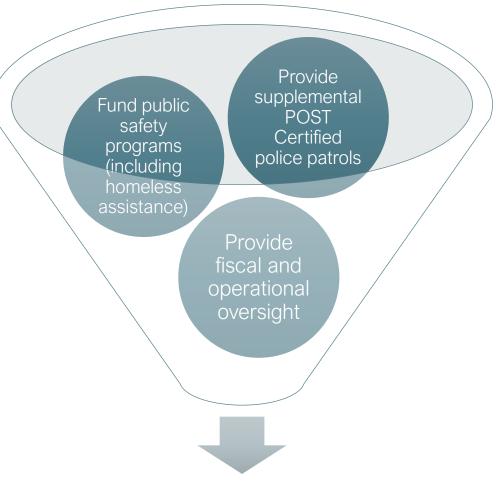

Implementation of FY2022 Budget Adjustment

- Homeless case management TASGNO agreement with French Market Corporation
 executed, two fulltime case managers for field outreach have been hired and actively working
 in coordination with the French Market Corporation and Downtown Development District
- Crime Cameras Procurement complete and installation that is fully integrated into the Real Time Crime Center underway
- Streetlight repairs as informed by FQMD Lighting Assessment underway. Streetlight installation with cost savings from reclaimed poles owned by the City pending.

Act of Donation executed for four more patrol vehicles donated to the SPPP and the cars are now rolling allowing for more shifts to be filled

VEHICLES PROCUREMENT

- Since the passage of the first budget in November 2021, no vehicles have been purchased for the police patrol program.
- FQEDD Agreement Monitors ask the City Council for help in procuring vehicles as soon as possible
- Include SPPP vehicles in the \$75M for special bids authorized by City Council
